Granny's Sweet Shoppe

Know someone with a sweet tooth? This is the perfect lap quilt for them! It features Northcott's *Granny's Sweet Shoppe* collection by Mary Anne Henderson - **Finished Size:** 45" x 57½" - **Number of Blocks & Finished Size:** six large jar blocks each 7" wide x 9" high, and nine small jar blocks each 4" wide x 9" high, plus one additional jar of each

Fabric Requirements: (Label the numbered pieces as indicated.)

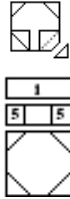
<p>A fat ⅛ each of #3576-24 lollipops, #3578-42 gummy worms, #3579-23 jujubes, #3580-71 licorice allsorts, #3581-24 gum balls & #3582-54 jellybeans</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> From the licorice, cut two 7½" squares, one 4½" x 7½" piece and one 1½" x 3" piece (reserve scraps for appliqué).</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> From the jujubes, cut one 7½" square and one 4½" x 7½" piece.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> From the remaining 4 fabrics, cut one 7½" square and two 4½" x 7½" pieces. Also cut one 1½" x 3" piece from the jellybeans fabric (reserve scraps for appliqué).</p>
<p>#2384-92 grey ombré fat ⅛</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 17 pieces 3" wide x 1½" high (for jar lids)</p>
<p>#322-35 hazel wood grain 1yd (.9m)</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 9 strips 1½" x width of fabric (WOF); cut into eighteen 9½" pieces (#7), six 7½" pieces (#1), nine 4½" pieces (#2), fourteen 2¾" pieces, and (#5) twenty 1¼" pieces (#4).</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 2 strips 2¾" x WOF; cut into twenty-eight 2¾" squares (#3)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 2 strips 1¼" x WOF; cut into forty 1¼" squares (#6)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 1 strip 7½" x WOF; cut into one 8½" piece (#9), one 6½" x 3½" piece (#11), one 14½" x 5½" piece (#10), one 8½" x 2½" piece (#13), one 5" x 1½" piece (#8), and one 4" x 1½" piece (#12)</p>
<p>#322-30 birch wood grain 1yd (.9m)</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 3 strips 5¼" x WOF; trim to 41"</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 1 strip 7¼" x WOF; trim to 41"</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 3 strips 2" x WOF; trim to 31½"</p>
<p>#313-99 black crackle 1½yds (1.1m)</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 2 strips 5" x WOF; trim to 41"</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 3 strips 2½" x WOF; join end-to-end and reserve for side borders.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut 6 strips 2¼" x WOF; join end-to-end, press in half lengthwise and reserve for binding.</p>
<p>Backing: 2⅞yds (2.6m) (I used the lollipop print #3576-24)</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Cut a piece 70". Cut balance into 3 equal 13" widths; join end-to-end and add to side of 70" piece.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Batting: a piece 51" x 63"</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> ½yd paper-backed fusible web, such as Wonder-Under</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Suggested thread for quilting: Highlights #712 Burnt Orange by Superior Threads</p>	

Piecing:

Large jars (6): 1. Sew a #5 onto each side of 6 gray pieces. Press seam towards gray.

2. Pin a #3 onto each corner of a 7½" candy square; sew diagonally as shown and trim ¼" past seam. Press seam towards candy fabric. Make 7. Set aside one licorice unit.

3. Sew the lid unit (step 1) to the jar unit (step 2). Add a #1 to the top. Press.



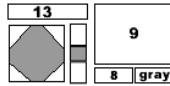
Tipped-over large jar: 1. Sew a #5 onto each side of the 3" licorice piece. Press seam toward licorice.

2. Sew to right side of the reserved licorice block.

3. Sew the #13 to the top edge.

4. Sew a #8 to the left side of a gray piece. Add a #9 to the top of this.

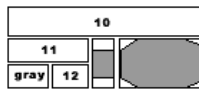
5. Sew the step 4 unit to the right side of the step 3 unit.



Small jars (9): 1. Using same method as for large jars, sew a #4 onto each side of 9 gray pieces.

2. Sew a #6 onto each corner of a 4½" x 7½" candy piece. Make 10. Set aside one jellybean unit.

3. Sew a lid unit to top of each jar unit, then add a #2 to top edge. Press.



Tipped-over small jar: 1. Sew a #4 to each side of the 3" jellybean piece.

2. Sew to the left side of the reserved jellybean jar unit.

3. Sew a #12 to right side of a gray piece. Add a #11 to top edge.

4. Sew the unit from step 3 to the left side of the jar unit from step 2. Add a #10 to top edge.

Assembly:

- Using the photo as a guide, make 1 row of 3 large jars, inserting a #7 between each jar.
- Make 1 row of 2 large jars and one tipped-over large jar, inserting a #7 between each jar.
- Make 1 row of 6 small jars, inserting a #7 between jars and at each end of the row.
- Make 1 row of 3 small jars and 1 tipped-over small jar, inserting a #7 between jars and at each end of the row.
- Sew the rows together, inserting a 31½" birch strip between rows.
- Add a 5¼" birch strip to each side, then a 5¼" strip to bottom edge and a 7¼" strip to top edge.
- Using a small plate and the photo as a guide, round off top corners. Repeat on bottom edge to make "legs" for the shelf.
- Press under ¼" on top edge from side to side, and on bottom edge.
- Lay a 41" black strip under top & bottom edges; pin edge of shelf onto black and appliqué in place invisibly by hand or machine.
- Measure length of quilt (approx. 57"), and cut two pieces from the 2½" wide prepared strip. Sew to each side.

Appliqués:

- Trace the Granny's Sweet Shoppe letters onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under. Fuse to the back of the remaining piece of black crackle following manufacturer's directions.
- Cut out letters, remove paper backing and fuse along the top of the shelf, using photo as a guide.
- Finish edges of appliqués with a short narrow zigzag.
- If desired, fuse some licorice and jellybean appliqués beside the tipped-over jars using the reserved scraps.

Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared black binding to the edges, turn and stitch in place. Enjoy your new quilt.

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
